Sources of locations before 1895

1)1831-1855 = "Lowell or Catholic Yard"

2) 27 March 1855 to 26 March 1876 the City Clerk recorded the specific site in the Cemetery. . The very next day records once again simply said "Cath Yard". During this period and beyond burials in Yard 1 simply were given as "1" as ranges and sections had not been laid out for that yard.
